Mr. GEPHARDT submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the House from the legislative day of Thursday, May 27, 1993, to Tuesday, June 8, 1993, and an adjournment or recess of the Senate from Friday, May 28, 1993, until Monday, June 7, 1993.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, May 27, 1993, it stand adjourned
4 until noon on Tuesday, June 8, 1993, or until noon on
5 the second day after Members are notified to reassemble
6 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
7 ever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses or
8 adjourns at the close of business on Friday, May 28, 1993,

1 pursuant to a motion made by the Majority Leader, or
2 his designee, in accordance with this resolution, it stand
3 recessed or adjourned until noon, or until such time as
4 may be specified by the Majority Leader or his designee
5 in the motion to adjourn or recess, on Monday, June 7,
6 1993, or until noon on the second day after Members are
7 notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concur-
8 rent resolution, whichever occurs first.

9 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
10 Leader of the Senate, acting jointing after consultation
11 with the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority
12 Leader of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the
13 House and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble when-
14 ever, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
