CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the House from the legislative day of Thursday, July 1, 1993 to Tuesday, July 13, 1993 and an adjournment or recess of the Senate from Thursday, July 1, 1993 or Friday, July 2, 1993 until Tuesday, July 13, 1993.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, July 1, 1993, it stand adjourned
4 until noon on Tuesday, July 13, 1993, or until noon on
5 the second day after Members are notified to reassemble
6 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
7 ever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses or
8 adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, July 1,
9 1993 or Friday, July 2, 1993, pursuant to a motion made
10 by the Majority Leader, or his designee, in accordance

1 with this resolution, it stand recessed or adjourned until
2 noon, or until such time as may be specified by the Major-
3 ity Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or ad-
4 journ, on Tuesday, July 13, 1993, or until noon on the
5 second day after Members are notified to reassemble pur-
6 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
7 occurs first.

8 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
9 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
10 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
11 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
12 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
13 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
