CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the House from Wednesday, November 10, 1993, to Monday, November 15, 1993, and an adjournment or recess of the Senate from Wednesday, November 10, 1993, to Tuesday, November 16, 1993.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on Wednes-
3 day, November 10, 1993, it stand adjourned until noon
4 on Monday, November 15, 1993, or until noon on the sec-
5 ond day after Members are notified to reassemble pursu-
6 ant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
7 occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses or ad-

1 journals at the close of business on Wednesday, November
2 10, 1993, pursuant to a motion made by the majority lead-
3 er or his designee, in accordance with this resolution, it
4 stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tuesday, No-
5 vember 16, 1993, or at such time as may be specified by
6 the majority leader or his designee in the motion to recess
7 or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after Members
8 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this
9 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

10 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the majority
11 leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
12 the minority leader of the House and the minority leader
13 of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and
14 the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their
15 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
