Providing for an adjournment of the two Houses.

H. CON. RES. 232

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, March 24, 1994, it stand adjourned
4 until noon on Tuesday, April 12, 1994, or until noon on
5 the second day after Members are notified to reassemble
6 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
7 ever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses or
8 adjourns at the close of business on Friday, March 25,
9 1994, Saturday, March 26, 1994, Monday, March 28,
10 1994, Tuesday, March 29, 1994, Wednesday, March 30,
11 1994, or Thursday, March 31, 1994, pursuant to a motion

1 made by the majority leader or his designee, in accordance
2 with this resolution, it stand recessed or adjourned until
3 noon on Monday, April 11, 1994, or at such time on that
4 day as may be specified by the majority leader or his des-
5 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon
6 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-
7 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
8 whichever occurs first.

9 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the majority
10 leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
11 the minority leader of the House and the minority leader
12 of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and
13 the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their
14 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
