CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the United States Congress that the Citizen's Stamp Advisory Committee of the United States Postal Service should recommend to the Postmaster General that a postage stamp be issued honoring coach Paul "Bear" Bryant.

Whereas the Citizen's Stamp Advisory Committee decides which individuals may be honored by having a stamp issued in their honor;

Whereas many sports heroes of the past have been honored in this manner;

Whereas Coach Paul William "Bear" Bryant is the most successful coach in college Division One football history;

Whereas Coach Bryant led his teams to 6 national championships, and holds the record for the most post season bowl appearances, and the most bowl wins;

Whereas Coach Bryant's winning history was a source of great pride to the University of Alabama and the Nation;

Whereas Paul "Bear" Bryant is a modern hero and legend in the South; and

Whereas the Postal Service's 10-year waiting period for such an honor has expired since "Bear" Bryant died on January 18, 1982: Now, therefore, be it
