## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Waiving the requirement in section 132 of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946 that the Congress adjourn sine die not later than July 31 of each year.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That, notwithstanding the provisions of sec-  
3 tion 132(a)(1) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of  
4 1946 (2 U.S.C. 198), the House of Representatives and  
5 the Senate shall not adjourn for a period in excess of three  
6 days, or adjourn sine die, until both Houses of Congress  
7 have adopted a concurrent resolution providing either for  
8 an adjournment (in excess of three days) to a day certain  
9 or for adjournment sine die.
