CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That a revised edition of the book entitled
3 “History of the United States House of Representatives”,
4 prepared under the supervision of the Committee on
5 House Administration of the House of Representatives,
6 shall be printed as a House document.

7 SEC. 2. In addition to the usual number, there shall
8 be printed the lesser of—

1 (1) 5,000 casebound copies of the document, of
2 which 4,750 copies shall be for the use of the Com-
3 mittee on House Administration of the House of
4 Representatives and 250 copies shall be for the use
5 of the Senate; or

6 (2) such number of casebound copies of the
7 document as does not exceed a total production and
8 printing cost of \$75,000, with such copies to be allo-
9 cated in the same proportion as described in para-
10 graph (1).

11 SEC. 3. Of the copies of the document for the use
12 of the Committee on House Administration of the House
13 of Representatives under section 2(1), at the request of
14 a Member of the House of Representatives, the Member
15 shall be entitled to receive at least 5 copies. The Commit-
16 tee shall notify each Member of the entitlement under the
17 preceding sentence. As used in this section, the term
18 “Member of the House of Representatives” means a Rep-
19 resentative in, or a Delegate or Resident Commissioner
20 to, the Congress.
