Mr. ROSE submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the printing of the book entitled “History of the United States House of Representatives”.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That a revised edition of the book entitled
3 “History of the United States House of Representatives”,
4 prepared under the supervision of the Committee on
5 House Administration of the House of Representatives,
6 shall be printed as a House document.

7 SEC. 2. In addition to the usual number, there shall
8 be printed the lesser of—

9 (1) 10,000 casebound copies of the document,
10 of which 9,500 copies shall be for the use of the

1 Committee on House Administration of the House of
2 Representatives and 500 copies shall be for the use
3 of the Senate; or

4 (2) such number of casebound copies of the
5 document as does not exceed a total production and
6 printing cost of \$150,000, with such copies to be al-
7 located in the same proportion as described in para-
8 graph (1).
