Mr. GONZALEZ introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to repeal the twenty-fifth amendment to that Constitution.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*
3 *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-*
4 *lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-*
5 *stitution of the United States, to be valid only if ratified*
6 *by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States*

1 within seven years after the date of the final passage of
2 this joint resolution:

3 “ARTICLE —

4 “The twenty-fifth article of amendment to the Con-
5 stitution of the United States is hereby repealed.”.
