To designate February 1994 as “National Black History Month”.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That February 1994 is designated as “National Black
4 History Month”, and the President of the United States
5 is authorized and requested to issue a proclamation calling
6 upon the people of the United States to observe such
7 month with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
