## A BILL

To amend the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to expand the requirement that legislation be accompanied by cost estimates of its impact on State and local governments.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ANALYSIS BY CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET**  
4 **OFFICE.**

5 Section 403(a) of the Congressional Budget Act of  
6 1974 is amended—

7 (1) by inserting “or conference report” before  
8 “, and submit”;

1           (2) by striking “if timely submitted to such  
2           committee before such report is filed” and inserting  
3           “or the joint explanatory statement accompanying  
4           such conference report”; and

5           (3) by adding at the end the following new sen-  
6           tence: “It shall not be in order in the House of Rep-  
7           resentatives or the Senate to consider any significant  
8           bill or resolution, or any conference report on a sig-  
9           nificant bill or resolution, if the report accompanying  
10          the bill or resolution or the joint explanatory state-  
11          ment accompanying the conference report does not  
12          comply with the preceding sentence.”.

13 **SEC. 2. RECONCILIATION INSTRUCTIONS.**

14          Section 310(a) of the Congressional Budget Act of  
15          1974 is amended by striking “or” at the end of paragraph  
16          (3), by striking the period and inserting “; or” at the end  
17          of paragraph (4), and by inserting after paragraph (4) the  
18          following:

19                 “(5) direct any committee receiving an instruc-  
20                 tion under paragraph (1) or (2) to include the esti-  
21                 mate required by section 403(a) with the reconcili-  
22                 ation legislation that carries out such instruction.”.
