1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT EXEMPTION.**

4 (a) AMENDMENT.—Subsection (b)(2) of section 484E
5 of the Customs and Trade Act of 1990 (19 U.S.C. 1466
6 note) is amended to read as follows:

7 “(2) any entry made on or after the date of en-
8 actment of this Act.”

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) shall take effect January 1, 1993.
