1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN MENTHOL FEEDSTOCKS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 29 of the Harmonized
5 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by insert-
6 ing after subheading 2906.14.00 the following new
7 subheading, with the article description having the same
8 degree of indentation as the article description in sub-
9 heading 2906.19.00:

6 spect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for
7 consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date of
8 the enactment of this Act.
