4 Section 311(e)(2)(B)(i) of the Legislative Branch Ap-
5 propriations Act, 1991 (2 U.S.C. 59e(e)(2)(B)(i)) is
6 amended by striking “3” and inserting “2.4”.

7 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

8 The amendment made by this Act shall apply with
9 respect to sessions of Congress beginning with the first
