A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to change the rate of duty for certain bicycles.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN LIGHTWEIGHT BICYCLES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 87 of the Harmonized
5 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by redес-
6 ignating subheading 8712.00.40 as subheading
7 8712.00.45, and by inserting in numerical sequence the
8 following new subheadings, with superior text, with the su-
9 perior text having the same degree of indentation as the
10 article description for such subheading 8712.00.45:

	Bicycles having front wheels exceeding 55 cm in diameter but not exceeding 63.5 cm in diameter and rear wheels exceeding 63.5 cm in diameter, if weighing less than 16.3 kg complete without accessories and designed for use with tires having a cross-sectional diameter not exceeding 4.13 cm:			
8712.00.41	Valued at \$200 or greater ..	5.5%	Free (E, IL) 2.7% (CA)	30%
8712.00.42	Valued at less than \$200	15%	Free (E, IL) 7.5% (CA)	30%

1 (b) STAGED RATE REDUCTION.—Any staged reduc-
2 tion of a special rate of duty set forth in subheading
3 8712.00.25 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
4 United States that was proclaimed by the President before
5 the date of the enactment of this Act and that would oth-
6 erwise take effect after the date of the enactment of this
7 Act shall also apply to the corresponding special rate of
8 duty set forth in subheading 8712.00.41 (as added by sub-
9 section (a)).

10 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

11 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by this Act
12 shall apply with respect to articles entered, or withdrawn
13 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the date that
14 is 15 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.

15 (b) RELIQUIDATION.—Notwithstanding section 514
16 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other
17 provision of law, upon a request filed with the appropriate
18 customs officer before the date that is 90 days after the
19 date of the enactment of this Act, any entry of an article
20 described in subheading 8712.00.41 of the Harmonized

1 Tariff Schedule of the United States (as added by this
2 Act) that was made—

3 (1) after December 31, 1988; and

4 (2) on or before the date that is 15 days after
5 the date of the enactment of this Act,

6 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such entry
7 occurred on the day after the date that is 15 days after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
