A BILL

To provide that certain new Federal programs shall terminate no later than 5 years after the date of enactment of the law that establishes the programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF CERTAIN PROGRAMS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
5 (b), any Federal program established after the date of en-
6 actment of this Act shall terminate on the earlier of—

7 (1) any termination date specified for the pro-
8 gram by the provisions of the Act which authorizes
9 that program; or

1 (2) the date which is 5 years after the date of
2 enactment of such Act.

3 (b) NOT APPLICABLE TO ENTITLEMENTS.—Sub-
4 section (a) shall not apply to a program that requires a
5 payment by the United States to a person (including a
6 governmental entity) if, under the provisions of the Act
7 that authorizes the program, the United States is obli-
8 gated to make such payment to any person that meets
9 the eligibility requirements established under the program
10 for such payment.
