A BILL

To extend until January 1, 1995, the existing suspension of duty on 1-(3-Sulfopropyl) pyridinium hydroxide.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON 1-(3-**

4 **SULFOPROPYL) PYRIDINIUM HYDROXIDE.**

5 Heading 9902.29.75 of the Harmonized Tariff
6 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking “12/
7 31/90” and inserting “12/31/94”.

8 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE; RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY.**

9 (a) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Except as provided in sub-
10 section (b), the amendment made by section 1 applies with

1 respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse
2 for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date
3 of the enactment of this Act.

4 (b) RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY.—Notwithstanding
5 section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514)
6 or any other provision of law to the contrary, upon a re-
7 quest filed with the appropriate customs officer before the
8 90th day after the date of the enactment of this Act, any
9 entry or withdrawal from warehouse for consumption—

10 (1) which was made after December 31, 1990,
11 and before the 15th day after the date of enactment
12 of this Act; and

13 (2) with respect to which there would have been
14 no duty if any amendment made by section 1 applied
15 to such entry or withdrawal;

16 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such amend-
17 ment applied to such entry or withdrawal.
