Mr. DORNAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To restore the 1994 cost-of-living adjustment in the regular military compensation of members of the uniformed services on active duty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESTORATION OF THE 1994 COST-OF-LIVING**
4 **ADJUSTMENT FOR REGULAR MILITARY COM-**
5 **PENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE UNI-**
6 **FORMED SERVICES.**

7 (a) RESTORATION OF ADJUSTMENT.—Effective on
8 January 1, 1994, the rates of basic pay, basic allowance
9 for subsistence, and basic allowance for quarters of mem-

1 bers of the uniformed services on active duty for a period
2 of more than 30 days are increased by 2.2 percent.

3 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING SOURCE OF
4 FUNDS.—It is the sense of Congress that the funds nec-
5 essary to provide the increase in regular military com-
6 pensation required by subsection (a) should be derived
7 from reductions in other programs of the Department of
8 Defense within major functional category 050 (National
9 Defense) in the budget of the President submitted to Con-
10 gress pursuant to section 1105 of title 31, United States
11 Code, for fiscal year 1994.
