## A BILL

To designate the Federal building to be constructed between  
Gay and Market Streets and Cumberland and Church

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4       The Federal building to be constructed between Gay  
5       and Market Streets and Cumberland and Church Avenues  
6       in Knoxville, Tennessee, shall be known and designated  
7       as the “Howard H. Baker, Jr. United States Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal  
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be  
5 a reference to the “Howard H. Baker, Jr. United States  
6 Courthouse”.
