A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. OVERHAUL, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF**
4 **NAVAL VESSELS IN FOREIGN SHIPYARDS.**

5 (a) EXTENSION OF RESTRICTIONS.—Section
6 7309(c)(1) of title 10, United States Code, is amended
7 by striking out “the homeport of which is in the United
8 States”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) shall not apply with respect to the overhaul,
3 repair, or maintenance of a vessel for which work was
4 begun before the date of the enactment of this Act.
