A BILL

To require that States receiving State Legalization Impact Assistance Grants (SLIAG) cooperate with the Immigration and Naturalization Service and the Border Patrol in the apprehension, detention, and transfer of illegal immigrants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SLIAG REQUIREMENT.**

4 A State which is otherwise eligible to receive State
5 Legalization Impact Assistance Grants (SLIAG) may not
6 receive such payments until the Immigration and Natu-
7 ralization Service and the United States Border Patrol

1 certify to the Attorney General that law enforcement offi-
2 cials of such State cooperate with Federal officials in the
3 apprehension, detention, and transfer of illegal immi-
4 grants.

5 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6 Section 1 shall take effect October 1, 1993.

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
