Mrs. JOHNSON of Connecticut (by request) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on 2,6-Dichlorobenzonitrile.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF**
4 **DUTY ON 2,6-DICHLOROBENZONITRILE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.30.69 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
7 by striking “12/31/92” and inserting “12/31/98”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered,
11 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on

1 or after the 15th day after the date of the enact-
2 ment of this Act.

3 (2) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION TO CERTAIN
4 ENTRIES.—Notwithstanding section 514 of the Tar-
5 iff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other provi-
6 sion of law, upon proper request filed with the ap-
7 propriate customs officer before the 90th day after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act, any entry, or
9 withdrawal from warehouse for consumption, of any
10 goods described in heading 9902.30.69 of the Har-
11 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States that
12 was made—

13 (A) after December 31, 1992; and

14 (B) before the 15th day after the date of
15 the enactment of this Act;

16 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such
17 entry or withdrawal occurred on the 15th day after
18 the date of the enactment of this Act.
