Mr. SHAYS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION LIMITATION AMOUNT FOR**
4 **MULTICANDIDATE POLITICAL COMMITTEE**
5 **CONTRIBUTIONS TO CANDIDATES.**

6 Section 315(a)(2)(A) of the Federal Election Cam-
7 paign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 441a(a)(2)(A)) is amended
8 by striking out “\$5,000” and inserting in lieu thereof
9 “\$500”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERCENTAGE LIMITATION ON CONTRIBUTIONS**
2 **FROM MULTICANDIDATE POLITICAL COM-**
3 **MITTEES.**

4 Section 315 of the Federal Election Campaign Act
5 of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 441a) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following new subsection:

7 “(i) A candidate for the office of Representative in,
8 or Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress
9 may not, with respect to a reporting period for an election,
10 accept contributions from multicandidate political commit-
11 tees totaling in excess of 25 percent of all contributions
12 accepted by the candidate with respect to the reporting
13 period.”.

14 **SEC. 3. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ELECTION LIMITA-**
15 **TION ON CONTRIBUTIONS FROM PERSONS**
16 **OTHER THAN LOCAL INDIVIDUAL RESIDENTS.**

17 Section 315 of the Federal Election Campaign Act
18 of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 441a), as amended by section 1, is fur-
19 ther amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
20 section:

21 “(j)(1) A candidate for the office of Representative
22 in, or Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress
23 may not, with respect to a reporting period for an election,
24 accept contributions from persons other than local individ-
25 ual residents totaling in excess of 25 percent of all con-

1 tributions accepted by the candidate with respect to the
2 reporting period.

3 “(2) As used in this subsection, the term ‘local indi-
4 vidual resident’ means an individual who resides in the
5 congressional district involved.”.
