Mr. DUNCAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of John W. Ruth, Sr.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF CLAIM AGAINST THE UNITED**
4 **STATES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
6 shall pay, out of money in the Treasury not otherwise ap-
7 propriated, to John W. Ruth, Sr., of Knoxville, Tennessee,
8 a sum of money as compensation for the losses he incurred
9 from 1969 through 1974 when he detrimentally relied on
10 assurances by Federal officials during his participation in
11 Federal efforts to build highways in the Appalachian re-
12 gion.

1 (b) SATISFACTION OF CLAIM.—The payment made
2 under subsection (a) shall be in full satisfaction of all
3 claims John W. Ruth, Sr., may have against the United
4 States in connection with the losses described in sub-
5 section (a).

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.**

7 It shall be unlawful for an amount that exceeds 10
8 percent of the sum paid by the Secretary of the Treasury
9 under section 1 to be paid to or received by any agent
10 or attorney for services rendered in connection with the
11 benefits provided by this Act. Any person who violates this
12 section shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject
13 to a fine in the amount provided under title 18, United
14 States Code.
