A BILL

To continue until the close of December 31, 1994, the existing suspension of duties on color couplers and coupler intermediates used in the manufacture of photographic sensitized material.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXISTING SUSPENSION.**

4 Headings 9902.29.01 and 9902.37.07 of chapter 99
5 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States
6 are each amended by striking out “12/31/92” and insert-
7 ing in lieu thereof “12/31/94”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
3 (b), the amendment made by section 1 applies with respect
4 to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for con-
5 sumption, on or after the 15th day after the date of the
6 enactment of this Act.

7 (b) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.—Notwithstanding
8 section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514)
9 or any other provision of law to the contrary, upon a re-
10 quest filed with the appropriate customs officer before the
11 90th day after the date of the enactment of this Act, any
12 entry or withdrawal from warehouse for consumption—

13 (1) which was made after December 31, 1992,
14 and before the 15th day after the date of the enact-
15 ment of this Act; and

16 (2) with respect to which there would have been
17 no duty if any amendment made by section 1 applied
18 to such entry or withdrawal;

19 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such amend-
20 ment applied to such entry or withdrawal.
