Mr. GONZALEZ (for himself and Mrs. ROUKEMA) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs

A BILL

To extend certain programs relating to housing and
community development, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Housing Programs
5 Extension Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL COMMISSION ON MANUFACTURED HOUS-**
7 **ING.**

8 (a) EXTENSION OF COMMISSION.—Section 943(g) of
9 the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act
10 (Public Law 101–625; 104 Stat. 4415) is amended by

1 striking “on October 1, 1993” and inserting “at the end
2 of September 30, 1994”.

3 (b) FINAL REPORT.—Section 943(d)(2) of the Cran-
4 ston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act (Public
5 Law 101–625; 104 Stat. 4414) is amended by striking
6 “9 months after the Commission is established pursuant
7 to subsection (b)” and inserting “August 1, 1994”.

8 (c) INTERIM REPORT.—Section 943(d) of the Cran-
9 ston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act (Public
10 Law 101–625; 104 Stat. 4414) is amended—

11 (1) by redesignating paragraph (2) (as amend-
12 ed by subsection (b) of this section) as paragraph
13 (3); and

14 (2) by inserting after paragraph (1) the follow-
15 ing new paragraph:

16 “(2) INTERIM REPORT.—Not later than March
17 1, 1994, the Commission shall submit an interim re-
18 port to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Devel-
19 opment and the Congress. The report shall describe
20 the activities of the Commission under paragraph
21 (1) and shall contain any information specified in
22 such paragraph that is available to the Commission
23 and any evaluations and recommendations specified
24 in such paragraph that may be made by the Com-
25 mission, at such time.”.

1 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
2 943(f) of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable
3 Housing Act (Public Law 101–625; 104 Stat. 4415) is
4 amended by inserting after the first sentence the following
5 new sentence: “There are authorized to be appropriated
6 for fiscal year 1994 such sums as may be necessary to
7 carry out this section.”.

8 **SEC. 3. RECIPROCITY IN APPROVAL OF HOUSING SUBDIVI-**
9 **SIONS AMONG FEDERAL AGENCIES.**

10 (a) EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY.—Section 535(b) of
11 the Housing Act of 1949 (42 U.S.C. 1490o(b)) is amended
12 by striking “June 15, 1993” and inserting “September
13 30, 1994”.

14 (b) RETROACTIVITY.—Any administrative approval of
15 any housing subdivision made after June 15, 1993, and
16 before the date of the enactment of this Act is approved
17 and shall be considered to have been lawfully made, but
18 only if otherwise made in accordance with the provisions
19 of section 535(b) of the Housing Act of 1949.

20 **SEC. 4. FHA INSURANCE AUTHORITY.**

21 Section 531(b) of the National Housing Act (12
22 U.S.C. 1735f–9(b)) is amended by striking
23 “\$65,905,824,960” and inserting “\$92,146,000,000”.

1 **SEC. 5. GNMA GUARANTEE AUTHORITY.**

2 Section 306(g)(2) of the National Housing Act (12
3 U.S.C. 1721(g)(2)) is amended by striking
4 “\$88,000,000,000” and inserting “\$107,700,000,000”.

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
