## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to make certain drug offenses under State law predicate offenses under the armed career criminal statute.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Armed Career Crimi-  
5       nal Clarification Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. CERTAIN DRUG OFFENSES UNDER STATE LAW**  
7                       **MADE PREDICATE OFFENSES UNDER THE**  
8                       **ARMED CAREER CRIMINAL STATUTE.**

9       Section 924(e)(2)(A) of title 18, United States Code,  
10      is amended—

1 (1) in clause (i), by striking “or” at the end;

2 (2) in clause (ii), by adding “or” at the end;

3 and

4 (3) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(iii) an offense under State law which, if  
6 it had been prosecuted as a violation of the  
7 Controlled Substances Act at the time of the of-  
8 fense and because of the type and quantity of  
9 the controlled substance involved, would have  
10 been punishable by a maximum term of impris-  
11 onment of ten years or more;”.
