A BILL

For the relief of Olga D. Zhondetskaya.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANT OF NATURALIZATION TO OLGA D.**
4 **ZHONDETSKAYA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the inability of
6 Olga D. Zhondetskaya to meet the requirements of section
7 316 of the Immigration and Nationality Act that relate
8 to residence and physical presence in the United States,
9 she shall be naturalized as a citizen of the United States
10 upon the filing of the appropriate application and upon
11 being administered the oath of renunciation and allegiance

1 pursuant to section 337 of the Immigration and National-
2 ity Act.

3 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
4 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application
5 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 1
6 year of the date of the enactment of this Act.
