A BILL

Relating to the tariff treatment of Benthioncarb.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BENTHIONCARB.**

4 Chapter 29 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
5 United States is amended by striking out subheading
6 2930.90.10 and inserting the following new subheadings
7 and superior heading thereto with the superior heading
8 having the same degree of indentation as the superior
9 heading to subheadings 2930.90.24 and 2930.90.28:

2930.90.11	Pesticides: S-(4-Chlorobenzyl)-N,N- diethyl-thiocarbamate (Benthiocarb)	6.8%	Free (A*, CA, E, IL, J)	15.4c/ kg+ 64.5%
2930.90.13	Other	12.5%	Free (A*, CA, E, IL, J)	15.4c/ kg+ 64.5%

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by section
3 1 shall apply with respect to goods entered, or withdrawn
4 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
5 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

6 (b) RETROACTIVE PROVISION.—Notwithstanding sec-
7 tion 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision
8 of law to the contrary, upon a request filed with the appro-
9 priate customs officer before the 90th day after the date
10 of the enactment of this Act, any entry or withdrawal from
11 warehouse for consumption of goods to which the amend-
12 ment made by section 1 applies and that was made—

13 (1) after December 31, 1988; and

14 (2) before the 15th day after the date of the en-
15 actment of this Act;

16 and with respect to which there would have been a lower
17 duty if the amendment made by section 1 had applied to
18 such entry or withdrawal, shall be liquidated or
19 reliquidated as though such entry or withdrawal had oc-
20 curred on such 15th day.

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
