A BILL

To extend until December 31, 1998, the temporary suspension of duties on 2,6-Dichlorobenzonitrile, relating to mixtures and inerts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF**
4 **DUTIES ON 2,6-DICHLOROBENZONITRILE RE-**
5 **LATING TO MIXTURES AND INERTS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.38.14 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
8 by striking “12/31/92” and inserting “12/31/98”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered,
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on
4 or after the fifteenth day after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act.

6 (2) RELIQUIDATION.—Notwithstanding section
7 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or
8 any other provision of law, upon proper request filed
9 with the appropriate customs officer on or before the
10 date which is ninety days after the date of enact-
11 ment of this Act, any entry, or withdrawal from
12 warehouse for consumption, of an article described
13 in heading 9902.38.14 of the Harmonized Tariff
14 Schedule of the United States that was made—

15 (A) after December 31, 1992, and

16 (B) before the fifteenth day after the date
17 of enactment of this Act;

18 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such
19 entry or withdrawal occurred on the date that is fif-
20 teen days after the date of the enactment of this
21 Act.

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
