## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on synthetic staple fibers containing 84 percent or more by weight of vinyl chloride and 14 percent or more by weight of vinyl acetate.

3       That subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-  
4       iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting  
5       in numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.55.03	Synthetic staple fibers, not carded, combed or otherwise processed for spinning (provided for in heading 5503): Containing 84 percent or more by weight of vinyl chloride and 14 percent or more by weight of vinyl acetate .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/95	”.
