Mr. TRAFICANT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Vivian Eney.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF CLAIM.**

4 Notwithstanding section 3 of House Resolution 449,
5 adopted June 2, 1971, as enacted by chapter IV of the
6 Supplemental Appropriations Act of 1972 (40 U.S.C.
7 206b(e)), the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of
8 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the
9 sum of \$17,230.53 to Vivian Eney, widow of Christopher
10 Eney. This sum represents the value of the compensatory
11 time off Christopher Eney accrued for duty as a member
12 of the Capitol Police before his death. Payment of this

1 sum shall fully satisfy any claim Vivian Eney has against
2 the United States for the value of the compensatory time
3 off accrued by Christopher Eney for duty as a member
4 of the Capitol Police.

5 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FEES.**

6 No amount exceeding 10 percent of the payment
7 made under section 1 shall be paid to or received by any
8 agent or attorney in consideration for services rendered
9 in connection with the payment. Any person who violates
10 this section shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be
11 subject to a fine in the amount provided under section
12 3571 of title 18, United States Code.
