1 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF REDUCTION IN DEDUCTIBLE POR-**
2 **TION OF BUSINESS MEALS AND ENTERTAIN-**
3 **MENT.**

4 Section 13209 of the Revenue Reconciliation Act of
5 1993 is hereby repealed, and the Internal Revenue Code
6 of 1986 shall be applied and administered as if such sec-
7 tion (and the amendments made thereby) had not been
8 enacted.
