To amend the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1986 to provide for the continuation of the programs of such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Drug-Free Schools and
5 Communities Act Amendments of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR PRO-**
2 **GRAMS OF DRUG-FREE SCHOOLS AND COM-**
3 **MUNITIES ACT OF 1986.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5111(a)(1) of the Drug-
5 Free Schools and Communities Act of 1986 (42 U.S.C.
6 3181(a)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and” after “1989,”; and

8 (2) by inserting before the period the following:

9 “, and such sums as may be necessary for each of
10 the fiscal years 1994 through 1998”.

11 (b) TRAINING OF TEACHERS, COUNSELORS, AND
12 SCHOOL PERSONNEL; EMERGENCY GRANTS.—Section
13 5111(a)(2)(A) of the Drug-Free Schools and Communities
14 Act of 1986 (42 U.S.C. 3181(a)(2)(A)) is amended—

15 (1) by striking “and” after “1989,”; and

16 (2) by inserting before the period the following:

17 “, and such sums as may be necessary for each of
18 the fiscal years 1994 through 1998”.

19 (c) EMERGENCY GRANTS.—Section 5111(a)(3) of the
20 Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1986 (42
21 U.S.C. 3181(a)(3)) is amended by inserting before the pe-
22 riod the following: “, and such sums as may be necessary
23 for each of the fiscal years 1994 through 1998”.
