## AN ACT

To amend the Defense Department Overseas Teachers Pay  
and Personnel Practices Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. LEAVE FOR DODDS TEACHERS.**

4       Section 6 of the Defense Department Overseas  
5 Teachers Pay and Personnel Practices Act (20 U.S.C.  
6 904) is amended—

7               (1) in subsection (a) by inserting “(or, if such  
8       teacher is employed in a supervisory position or  
9       higher, not less than ten and not more than thir-  
10       teen)” after “ten”;

11               (2) in subsection (d) by striking “of the mili-  
12       tary department concerned” and inserting “of De-  
13       fense”; and

1 (3) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(h) The Director of Dependents’ Education, in con-  
3 sultation with the Director of the Office of Personnel Man-  
4 agement—

5 “(1) shall establish for teachers a voluntary  
6 leave transfer program similar to the one under sub-  
7 chapter III of chapter 63 of title 5, United States  
8 Code; and

9 “(2) may establish for teachers a voluntary  
10 leave bank program similar to the one under sub-  
11 chapter IV of chapter 63 of title 5, United States  
12 Code.

13 Only leave described in the last sentence of subsection (c)  
14 of this section (relating to leave that may be used by a  
15 teacher for any purpose) may be transferred under any  
16 program established under this subsection.”.
