Mr. STUDDS (for himself, Mr. MANTON, Mr. YOUNG of Alaska, and Mr. FIELDS of Texas) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries

A BILL

To approve a Governing International Fisheries Agreement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Agreement between the Government of the
4 United States of America and the Government of the Rus-
5 sian Federation on Mutual Fisheries Relations which was
6 entered into on May 31, 1988, and which expired by its
7 terms on October 28, 1993, may be brought into force
8 again for the United States through an exchange of notes
9 between the United States of America and the Russian
10 Federation and may remain in force and effect on the part
11 of the United States until May 1, 1994, and may be

1 amended or extended by a subsequent agreement to which
2 section 203 of the Magnuson Fishery Conservation and
3 Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1823) applies.
