Mr. GONZALEZ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Wolfgang Dietrich Hofmann.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR DEPORTATION OR**
4 **EXCLUSION OF WOLFGANG DIETRICH**
5 **HOFMANN.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections
7 212(a)(2)(A) and 241(a)(1)(A) of the Immigration and
8 Nationality Act, Wolfgang Dietrich Hofmann may not be
9 deported from the United States or excluded from admis-
10 sion into the United States by reason of his conviction of
11 any crime that occurred prior to January 1, 1980, and
12 that is reflected in the records of the Immigration and

1 Naturalization Service of the Department of Justice or the
2 Visa Office of the Department of State on the date of the
3 enactment of this Act.

4 (b) RESCISSION OF OUTSTANDING DEPORTATION
5 ORDER.—The Attorney General shall rescind any out-
6 standing order of deportation or finding of deportability
7 that has been entered against Wolfgang Dietrich Hofmann
8 by reason of his conviction of any crime that occurred
9 prior to January 1, 1980.

10 (c) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Wolfgang Dietrich
11 Hofmann enters the United States before the filing dead-
12 line specified in subsection (e), he shall be considered to
13 have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise
14 eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under section
15 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date
16 of the enactment of this Act.

17 (d) ESTABLISHMENT OF GOOD MORAL CHAR-
18 ACTER.—Notwithstanding section 101(f) of the Immigra-
19 tion and Nationality Act, any crime with respect to which
20 a judgment of conviction was entered against Wolfgang
21 Dietrich Hofmann prior to January 1, 1980, may not be
22 considered in determining whether he is, or during any
23 period has been, a person of good moral character for pur-
24 poses of such Act.

1 (e) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
2 FEES.—Subsection (c) shall apply only if Wolfgang
3 Dietrich Hofmann applies for adjustment of status and
4 pays the appropriate fees within two years after the date
5 of the enactment of this Act.
