## A BILL

To clarify the tariff classification of certain organo-phosphorous compounds and preparations thereof.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ORGANO-PHOSPHOROUS COM-**  
4 **POUNDS.**

5 Chapter 29 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the  
6 United States is amended by striking subheading  
7 2931.00.50 and inserting in numerical sequence the fol-  
8 lowing new superior text and subheadings, with the article  
9 description for subheading 2931.00.45 having the same

1 degree of indentation as the article description in sub-  
 2 heading 2931.00.10:

“	2931.00.45	Other: N-(Phosphonomethyl)glycine; Phosphonomethyliminodiacetic acid; Aminomethane phosphonic acid; and their salts and esters .....	12.5%	Free (E,IL,CA)	15.4¢/kg + 68%	”.
	2931.00.55	Other .....	3.7%	Free (A*,CA, E,IL,J)	25%	

3 **SEC. 2. PREPARATIONS CONTAINING CERTAIN ORGANO-**  
 4 **PHOSPHOROUS COMPOUNDS.**

5 Chapter 38 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the  
 6 United States is amended by inserting in numerical se-  
 7 quence the following new superior text and subheading,  
 8 with the article description having the same indentation  
 9 as the article description in subheading 3808.30.20:

“	3808.30.15	Other: Containing N- (phosphonomethyl)glycine or its salts or esters .....	12.5%	Free (E,CA,IL)	15.4¢/kg + 68%	”.

10 **SEC. 3. APPLICABILITY.**
