To improve the administration of the Women's Rights National Historical Park in the State of New York, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL PROPERTIES.**

4 Section 1601(c) of the Act of December 28, 1980 (16
5 U.S.C. 410 ll) is amended as follows:

6 (1) Strike “initially”.

7 (2) Strike “and” at the end of paragraph (8).

8 (3) Strike the period at the end of paragraph
9 (9) and insert a semicolon.

10 (4) Add the following at the end thereof:

11 “(10) not to exceed 1 acre, plus improvements,
12 as determined by the Secretary, in Seneca Falls for
13 development of a maintenance facility;

14 “(11) dwelling, 1 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;

15 “(12) dwelling, 10 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;

16 “(13) parcels adjacent to Wesleyan Chapel
17 Block, including Clinton Street, Fall Street, and
18 Mynderse Street, Seneca Falls; and

19 “(14) dwelling, 12 East Williams Street, Water-
20 loo.”.

21 **SEC. 2. MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS TO 1980 ACT.**

22 Section 1601 of the Act of December 28, 1980 (16
23 U.S.C. 410 ll) is amended as follows:

24 (1) ~~Add the following sentence at the end of~~
25 ~~subsection (g): “Funds available to the Secretary for~~

1 the purposes of the park shall be available to estab-
2 lish and administer education and research facilities
3 and programs on the history of women's rights with-
4 in the park pursuant to cooperative agreements with
5 appropriate public or private entities.”.

6 (2) In subsection (h)(5) strike “ten years” and
7 insert “25 years”.

8 (3) In subsection (i) strike “\$700,000” and
9 “\$500,000” and insert “\$1,500,000” and
10 “\$15,000,000” respectively.

11 (1) Insert “(1)” after “(i)” in subsection (i) and
12 add at the end of such subsection (i) the following
13 new paragraph:

14 “(2) In addition to those sums previously appro-
15 priated for land acquisition and development, there is here-
16 by authorized to be appropriated for fiscal years after Sep-
17 tember 30, 1994, \$2,000,000.”.

18 (2) In subsection (c) delete paragraph (7) and
19 renumber the remaining paragraphs accordingly.
