1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR CONCURRENT RECEIPT OF**
2 **SPECIAL SEPARATION BENEFIT AND DISABIL-**
3 **ITY COMPENSATION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1174a(g) of title 10,
5 United States Code, is amended by striking out “sub-
6 section (e)(2)(A)” and inserting in lieu thereof “sub-
7 sections (e)(2)(A) and (h)(2)”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) shall take effect as of December 5, 1991.
