Mr. INGLIS of South Carolina introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

## A BILL

To end the purchase of House calendars, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act shall be cited as the “End Purchase of  
5 House Calendars Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. END PURCHASE OF HOUSE CALENDARS.**

7 No funds shall be appropriated for the purchase of  
8 House calendars from the Capitol Historical Society or  
9 any other source and no funds shall be used in administer-  
10 ing or distributing House calendars for fiscal year 1995  
11 and any future fiscal years.

1 **SEC. 3. CALENDAR MAILING.**

2       No funds shall be appropriated for the mailing of cal-  
3 endars and no funds shall be used in administering the  
4 mailing of calendars for fiscal year 1995 and any future  
5 fiscal years.
