3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON 2-(4-CHLORO-2-**
4 **METHYL PHENOXY) PROPIONIC ACID.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new subheading:

“	9902.31.12	2-(4-chloro-2-methyl phenoxy) propionic acid (CAS No. 93-65-2) (provided for in HTS sub-heading 2918.90.10.00) (commonly called propionic acid and its salts)	Free	No Change	No Change	On or before 12/31/96	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section applies with respect to articles entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
