A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to require that recipients of Pell Grants be citizens or nationals of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE HIGHER EDUCATION ACT**
4 **OF 1965.**

5 Section 401(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
6 (20 U.S.C. 1070a(a)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “(defined in
8 accordance with section 484)”; and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following new
2 paragraph:

3 “(4) For the purposes of this section, the term ‘eligi-
4 ble student’ means a student who—

5 “(A) meets the requirements of paragraphs (1)
6 through (4) of section 484(a); and

7 “(B) is a citizen or national of the United
8 States.”.

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
