A BILL

To prohibit discrimination on account of sexual orientation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Civil Rights Act of
3 1993”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.**

5 It shall be unlawful to discriminate against any per-
6 son—

7 (1) in employment, education, credit, or hous-
8 ing;

9 (2) in the sale or use of goods or services;

10 (3) with respect to any public facility; or

11 (4) in any federally assisted program or
12 activity;

13 on account of that person’s sexual orientation, actual or
14 perceived.
