1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE STATUS FOR JORGE**

4 **LUIS DOS SANTOS, SUZETE DE S. TENORIO,**

5 **LUIS ANTONIO CARDOSO TENORIO, AND**

6 **JULLYE TENORIO.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b), for pur-
8 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Jorge Luis
9 Dos Santos, Suzete de S. Tenorio, Luis Antonio Cardoso
10 Tenorio, and Jullye Tenorio shall be considered to have

1 been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent
2 residence as of the date of the enactment of this Act, upon
3 payment of the required visa fees.

4 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION.—Subsection (a)
5 shall apply only if an individual under such subsection ap-
6 plies to the Attorney General for permanent residence sta-
7 tus pursuant to such subsection within 2 years after the
8 date of the enactment of this Act.
