## A BILL

To extend the authorization for appropriations for the Commodity Futures Trading Commission for five fiscal years.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       That this Act may be cited as the “CFTC Reauthorization  
4       Act of 1994”.

5       **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

6       Effective October 1, 1994, section 12(d) of the Com-  
7       modity Exchange Act (7 U.S.C. 16(d)) is amended to read  
8       as follows:

1       “(d) To carry out this Act, there are authorized to  
2 be appropriated such sums as are necessary for each of  
3 the 1995 through 1999 fiscal years.”.
