A BILL

To amend the Federal Aviation Act of 1958 to prohibit smoking on all scheduled airline flight segments in air transportation or intrastate air transportation.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Airliner Cabin Air
5 Quality Act of 1994”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST SMOKING ON SCHEDULED**
7 **FLIGHTS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 404(d)(1)(A) of the Fed-
9 eral Aviation Act of 1958 (49 U.S.C. App. 1374(d)(1)(A))

1 is amended by striking “, which is” and all that follows
2 before the period at the end.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) shall take effect on the 60th day following
5 the date of the enactment of this Act.
