AN ACT

To designate the building located at 2200 North Highway 67 in Florissant, Missouri, for the period of time during which it houses operations of the United States Postal Service, as the “John L. Lawler, Jr. Post Office”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The building located at 2200 North Highway 67 in
5 Florissant, Missouri, shall, for the period of time during
6 which it houses operations of the United States Postal
7 Service, be known and designated as the “John L. Lawler,
8 Jr. Post Office”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building
4 referred to in section 1 shall, with respect to the period
5 referred to in section 1, be deemed to be a reference to
6 the John L. Lawler, Jr. Post Office.
