A BILL

To make applicable the provisions of the Act commonly known as the “Warren Act” to the Central Utah Project, Utah, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. APPLICATION OF THE WARREN ACT.**

4 (a) AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
5 may—

1 (1) enter into contracts with private entities
2 pursuant to the Act of February 21, 1911 (com-
3 monly known as the “Warren Act”) (36 Stat. 925
4 et seq., chapter 141; 43 U.S.C. 523 *et seq.*), for the
5 impounding, storage, and carriage of nonproject
6 water for domestic, municipal, fish and wildlife, in-
7 dustrial, and other beneficial purposes, using any fa-
8 cilities associated with the Central Utah Project,
9 Utah; and

10 (2) enter into agreements, under terms and
11 conditions authorized for contracts under such Act,
12 with appropriate officials of other Federal agencies,
13 municipalities, public water districts and agencies,
14 and States for impounding, storage, and carriage of
15 nonproject water for purposes described in para-
16 graph (1) using facilities referred to in such para-
17 graph.

18 (b) NONPROJECT WATER DEFINED.—In subsection
19 (a), the term “nonproject water” means water that is not
20 from a Federal Reclamation project.

21 **SEC. 2. UTAH RECLAMATION MITIGATION AND CONSERVA-**
22 **TION COMMISSION.**

23 *Section 301(d) of Public Law 102–575 (106 Stat.*
24 *4626) is amended by adding the following new paragraph*
25 *at the end:*

1 “(8) Any employee of the District or member of the
2 Board of Directors of the District may serve as a member
3 of the Commission.”.
