1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION OF DOLLAR THRESHOLD FOR CER-**

4 **TAIN REPORTS.**

5 Section 304(b)(5)(A) of the Federal Election Cam-
6 paign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 434(b)(5)(A)) is amended
7 by striking out “\$200” and inserting in lieu thereof
8 “\$20”.

1 **SEC. 2. SPECIAL REPORTING REQUIREMENT FOR TRAVEL.**

2 Section 304(b)(5)(A) of the Federal Election Cam-
3 paign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 434(b)(5)(A)), as amended
4 by section 1, is further amended by inserting after “pur-
5 pose” the following: “(including, with respect to travel, the
6 dates of the travel, each point of departure, layover, and
7 destination, and the identity of the traveler)”.
